

Central Georgia Circuit Shoot Rules

Four premier clay target clubs have joined forces to host the first annual Central Georgia Circuit Shoot. The circuit will consist of 8 stops, 2 at each club, utilizing the following facilities: Big Red Oak, Cherokee Rose, Meadows and Old Hudson. Below are the rules and guidelines to be followed at each event!

- Each Circuit Shoot will be a 1 day shoot
- Circuit Shoot courses will be a sporting course consisting of a minimum of 12 stations
- Lunch will be available to those that want it
- Practice/warm-up will be available
- Participating clubs will be in good standing with the NSCA and GSCA
- ALL NSCA and GSCA rules apply to each Circuit Shoot.
- All ties shall be decided by using predetermined tie breaker stations. Points will be given in the order placed after tie breakers have been determined
- Each circuit shoot will consist of a Main event where competitors are awarded points. Host club can decide what/if there will be a secondary event
- Costs: Main event at the Circuit Shoots will be \$85 including NSCA and GSCA fees. \$10 goes back to class and \$10 goes to the end of year payout.
- Guarantee end of year purse: \$5,000
- Prizes: Each time a shooter participates their name will go into an end of year drawing where 5 lucky winners will win a 1 year membership to all 4 clubs!
- End of year purse payout will be broken out as follows:
 - o 1st – 25%
 - o 2nd – 18%
 - o 3rd – 14%
 - o 4th – 10%
 - o 5th – 8%
 - o 6th-10th – 5%
- Points will be awarded by class as follows:
 - o 1st – 100
 - o 2nd – 90
 - o 3rd – 80
 - o 4th – 70
 - o 5th – 60
 - o 6th + - 50
- A Shooter's 6 highest scores will be counted for point standings. At least one of those scores must come from each of the 4 clubs. (Ex: if a shooter skips both shoots at a specific club then only a max of 5 scores will count towards the total. If a shooter misses 1 event at 2 different clubs but shoots everything else then they will have 6 total scores towards the final. This tour is meant to encourage shooters to visit each of the clubs hosting)
- The day of the event the main event course will be closed to the public to provide competitors with exclusive access to premium competition targets without excessive backups.
- If a Circuit Shoot event has to be cancelled due to weather it will be rescheduled later in the year.
